

NCOA South Baseball-C19 Unsanctioned Contact Policy

The policy below pertains to any NCOA-South baseball member, engaging in and with an **unsanctioned league/game, in ANY sport that NCOA-South provides officials. Football, Volleyball, Wrestling, Basketball, Soccer, Softball, Baseball.

~Any Board member who engages with unsanctioned leagues/games, during any California state order, mandate, or guideline which prohibits youth sports due to the Covid19 pandemic, is thereby:

-Subject to suspension from Board position

-Subject to removal from Board position

-Subject to suspension from being “ready to be assigned” for a period of time to be determined by the NCOA Baseball Board of Directors. Period of time to be considered based on level of contact with unsanctioned leagues/games.

-Subject to status remanded to “member NOT in good standing” for a period of time to be determined by the NCOA Baseball Board of Directors

~Any member in good standing who engages with unsanctioned leagues/games, during any California state order, mandate, or guideline which prohibits youth sports due to the Covid19 pandemic, is thereby:

-Subject to suspension from being “ready to be assigned” for a period of time to be determined by the NCOA Baseball Board of Directors. Period of time to be considered based on level of contact with unsanctioned leagues/games.

-Subject to status remanded to “member NOT in good standing” for a period of time to be determined by the NCOA Baseball Board of Directors

~Any member NOT in good standing who engages with unsanctioned leagues/games, during any California state order, mandate, or guideline which prohibits youth sports due to the Covid19 pandemic, is thereby:

-Subject to status review by NCOA Baseball Board of Directors

-Subject to current status of “member NOT in good standing”, to be extended for a period of time to be determined by the NCOA Baseball Board of Directors.

** Unsanctioned league/game-defined as having one or more of, but not limited to, the following characteristics:

- Contests not sanctioned by the California Interscholastic Federation
- Sport teams consisting of HS aged athletes, predominantly from one school.
- Coached by a member of said school’s coaching/teaching staff.
- Are using said school’s facilities and/or equipment-regardless of any rental/purchase agreement purported by members of the unsanctioned organization in an attempt to appear not affiliated with said school.
- Are playing/participating during a California state order, or mandate, or guideline, which explicitly prohibits conducting practices and/or games specific to that sport.
- Are playing/participating during that sport’s “season of sport”, determined by the California Interscholastic Federation.
